I will respect and cooperate with others. I will do my best work and maintain high expectations for myself. I will dress in an appropriate manner conducive to learning, per school uniform policy. I will treat teachers, office staff and students in a dignified and professional manner. I will make good decisions.
As a PARENT:
 □ I will provide a time and place for my child to do school work. □ I will ensure that my child has the necessary school materials and a clean, quiet place to do homework (ie: monitor distractions such as television, video games and internet). □ I will frequently discuss schoolwork and activities with my child/children. □ I will take the initiative to monitor my student's academic performance. □ I will instill the importance of education in my child. □ I will do whatever it takes for child/children over the age of 10 to learn and prepare for college and life by supporting him/her and encouraging him/her to adhere to his/her "commitment to excellence".
 I will ensure that my child will attend school regularly and arrive on time, rested and prepared for school. If my child/children do not attend school on a regular basis, his/her promotion to the next grade level may be jeopardized after 10% absences from school or 18 days absent from school. A student who has excessive absences or identified as habitually truant, the district reserves the right to retain the student and not promote him/her to the next grade level (ARS 15-803). I will participate as often as it is possible in the learning and social activities of the school.

 I will attempt to volunteer at my child/children's school to help with school activities or other functions that will allow me to be parentally involved in their education and the community. I will ensure that my child under the age of 8 is reading or being read to every night. I will treat teachers, office staff and students in a dignified and professional manner. I will maintain regular contact with my child's teachers. I acknowledge that parents, not the school, are responsible for the behavior of my child. I acknowledge that the primary way for me to be involved in my child's education is by monitoring his/her homework, behavior, and performance. I will do this by reviewing his/her homework, class work and project for accuracy, completeness and neatness before their due date.
As a TEACHER:
 □ I will collaborate with families to support success in student learning. □ I will continue to grow professionally. □ I will create and maintain a positive learning environment. □ I will maintain high expectations and challenge your child with a curriculum aligned to state standards. □ I will place the student's well-being first and be available to assist him/her with their educational needs. □ I will communicate options and opportunities for families to improve student learning.
As a PRINCIPAL:
 I will provide an environment by which positive communication between parent, students and teachers will occur. I will provide leadership for a community that supports student learning. I will communicate options and opportunities for families to improve student learning.

Note: Failure to adhere to these commitments may cause my child to lose various school privileges and can lead to my child returning to his/her home school.
